Chris is the Director of Lexington United Volleyball (LUV), Lexington's new all-encompassing club for youth volleyball players ages 6-18. Lexington United will offer an elite club, regional program, camps, satellite camps, youth leagues, private lessons, recruiting education, team consultation and apparel, beginning this fall at KBA. Chris has a long 20 year history as a successful collegiate Division I coach, winning conference championships at Louisville, South Florida, James Madison, Pittsburgh and Kentucky. He was a three-time coach of the year, including the 2003 NCAA East Region coach of the year and participated in 8 NCAA tournaments, including the Sweet 16 while at Kentucky in 2009. He won 244 matches in 12 years as a head coach while at Pitt and JMU and has coached over 15 All-American's and 5 Player's of the Year in the CAA, Big East and SEC conferences. He has mentored former assistants currently coaching at Arkansas, Texas, TCU, College of Charleston, and Fairfield. Coach Beerman has also coached club volleyball in Tampa, FL and Louisville, KY as well as founding Valley Jrs. in Harrisonburg, VA. As a collegiate player, Chris was a two-time All-American at Ball State and led the Cardinals to 3 consecutive NCAA Men's Final Fours from 1988-90. Chris is married to Mary-Beth, also a former volleyball player at Ball State, and has two children- Kendall and Jackson.
